

Release Notes: Legends HD Firmware Day One Update 5.71.9 for Legends Ultimate CE-HD* (October 29, 2024)

Firmware Live Date: October 29, 2024

Highlights

The Day One Update on October 29, 2024, is necessary as it adds the following to the factory stock firmware:

1. Updated versions of the 300 built-in games will be downloaded to the device via Component Update
2. Enhanced RetroPlayer that adds features such as Horizontal & Vertical Scan Lines for the ultimate emulation experience
3. On-Device Purchasing (ODP) and Week One Deals™ (WOD)
4. Automatic blocking of AtGames Mature Audience™ (AMA) Content for subaccounts created in Parental Controls
5. Support for ArcadeNet® for Legends Ultimate CE-HD (coming November 8, 2024)

The firmware and components updates will automatically appear for download when you power on your internet connected Legends HD device.

Known Issues being worked on

1. Legends ID / Database in Sync session message flickers on top left of display
2. The following games may exhibit audio distortion:
 1. Wizard Fire
 2. Night Slashers
3. The following games will crash to the UI after attempting to launch them:
 1. Exhile: Wicked Phenomenon (Built-in game)
 2. Exhile: Turbo GrafX 16 (AppStoreX™ Gamepack)
 3. Final Zone II (Built-in game)
4. Atari 2600 games do not tell the user to press the Player 1 button to start them
5. Bring Your Own Game (BYOG) UCE games do not launch. This will be corrected in an upcoming release.
6. Some game titles may have very small text due to the length of the game's name(s)
7. BitLCD owners will notice that some games do not have marquees.
8. Some non-pinball games show Magic Pixel as the publisher.
9. The in-game overlay may fall outside the game's display area if Display Mode is set to Pixel Perfect or Center.
